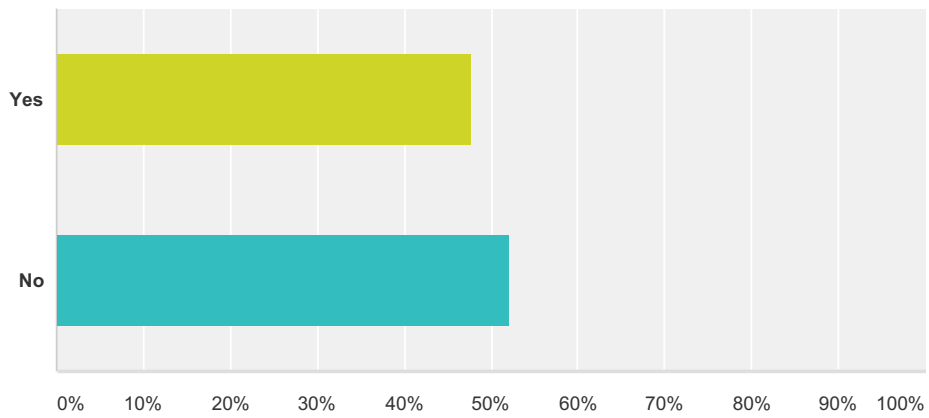


Q1 Do you (or does your child) currently have a 3in1 Card?

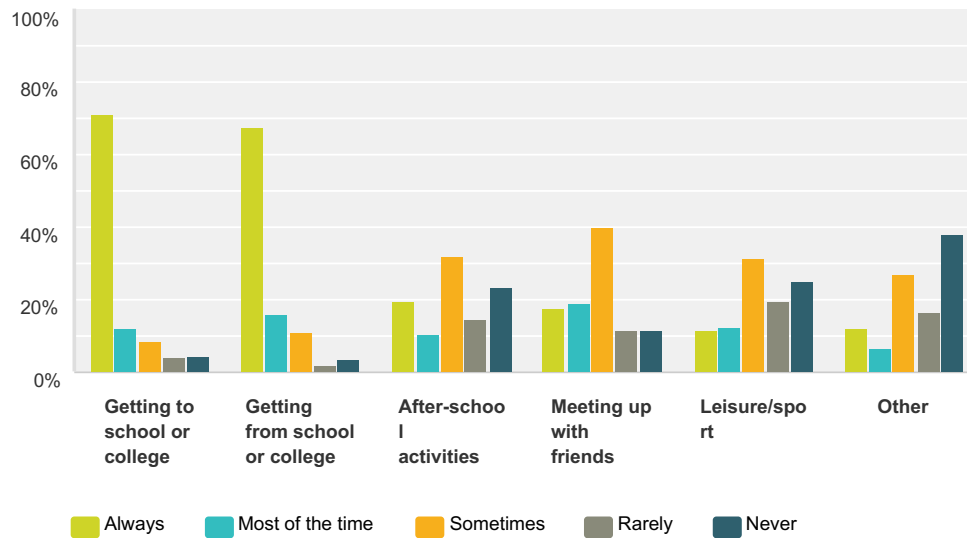

Q3 Which of the following journeys do you (or your child) make by bus?

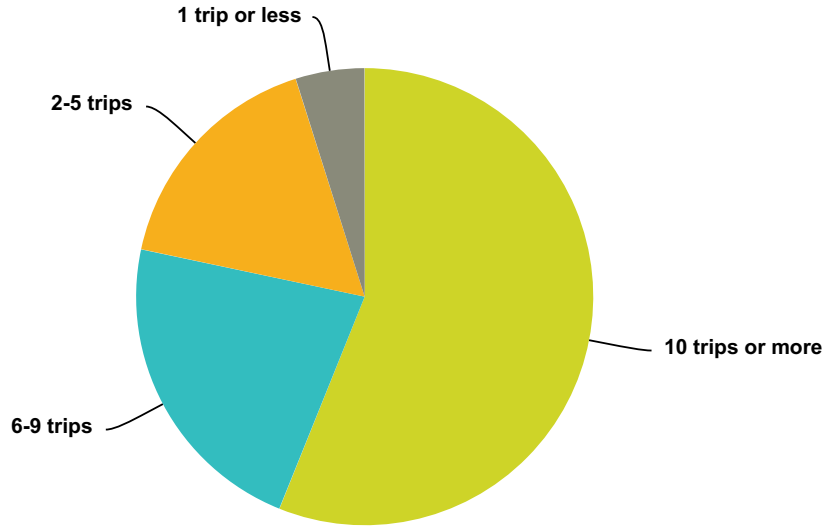

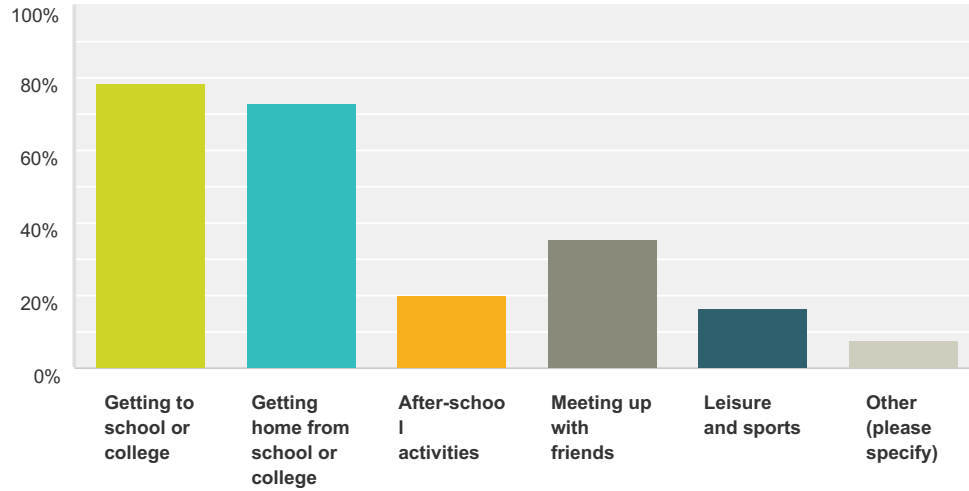

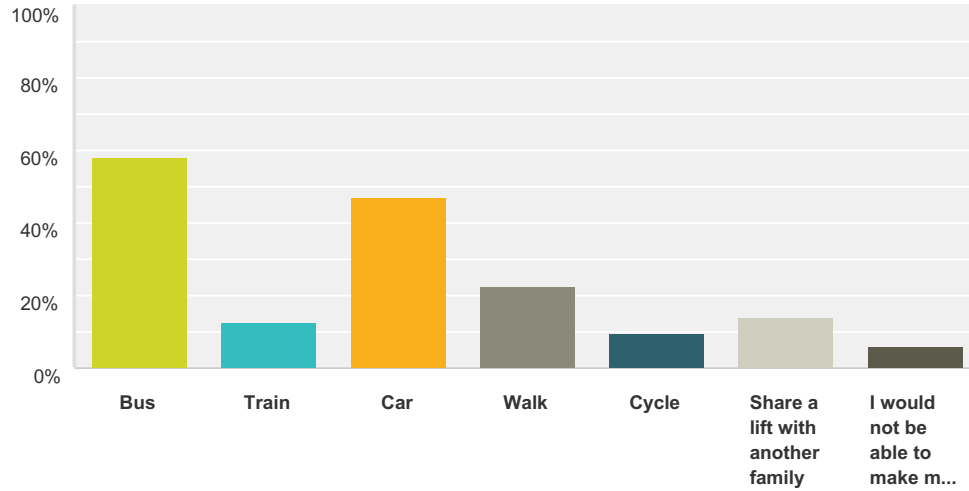

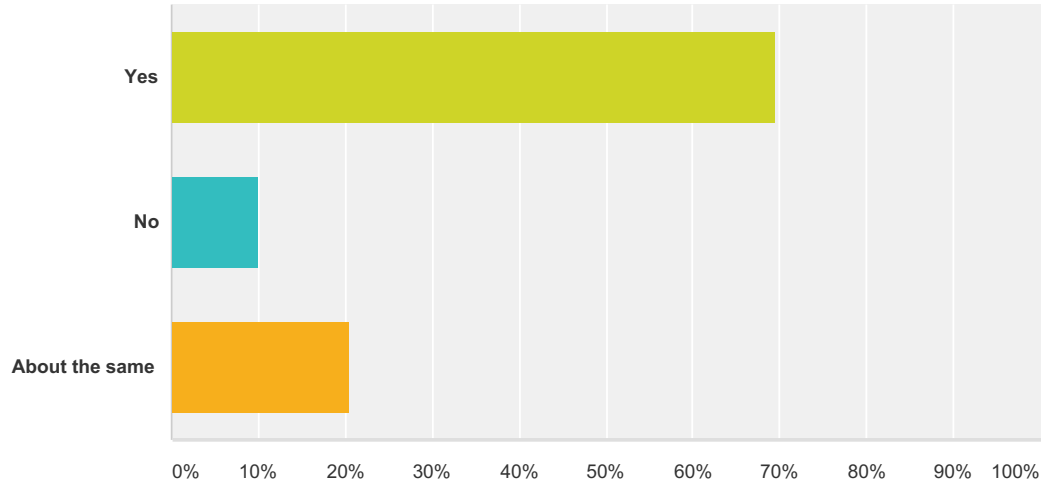

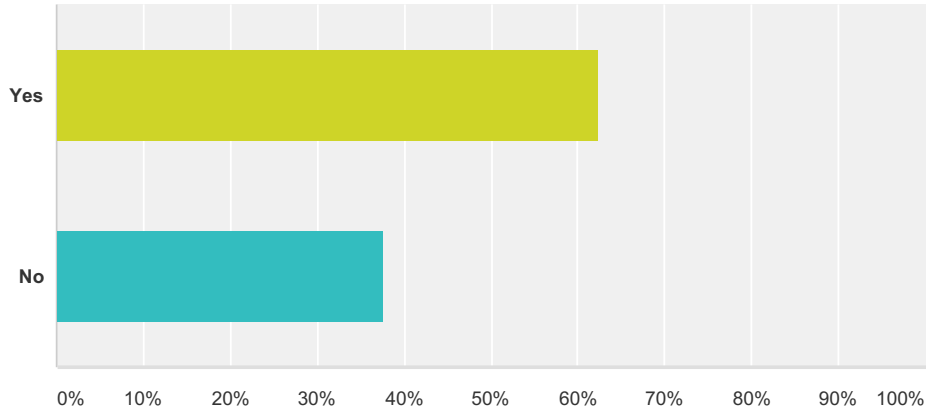

Q8 Has having the 3in1 Card encouraged you (or your child) to use the bus for journeys that you would otherwise have made by car?

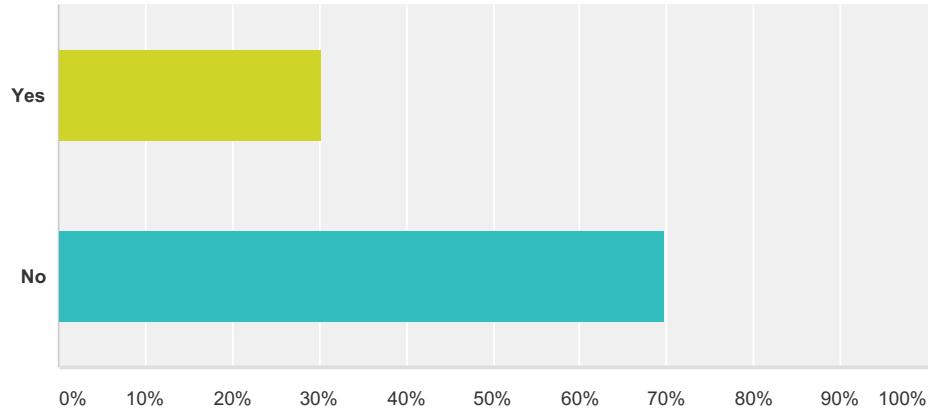

Q9 Did having cheaper bus fares offered by the 3in1 Card influence your (or your child's) current choice of school or college?

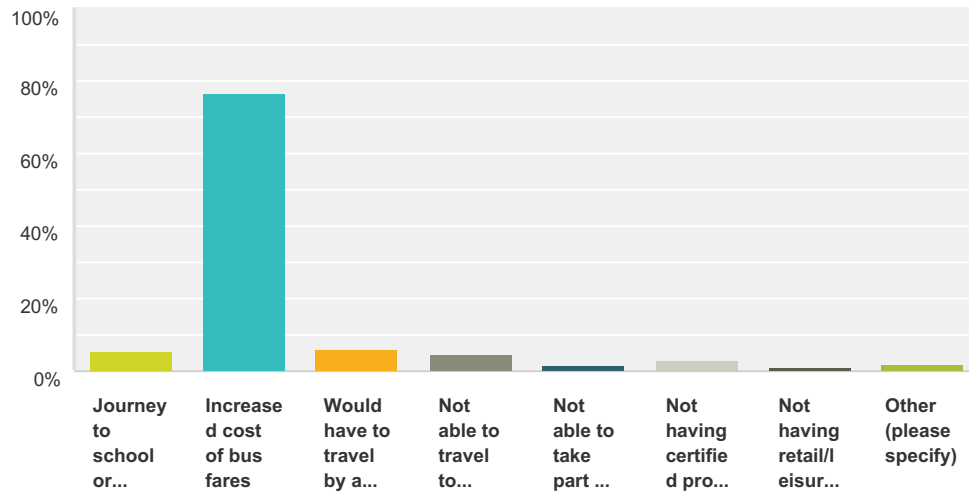

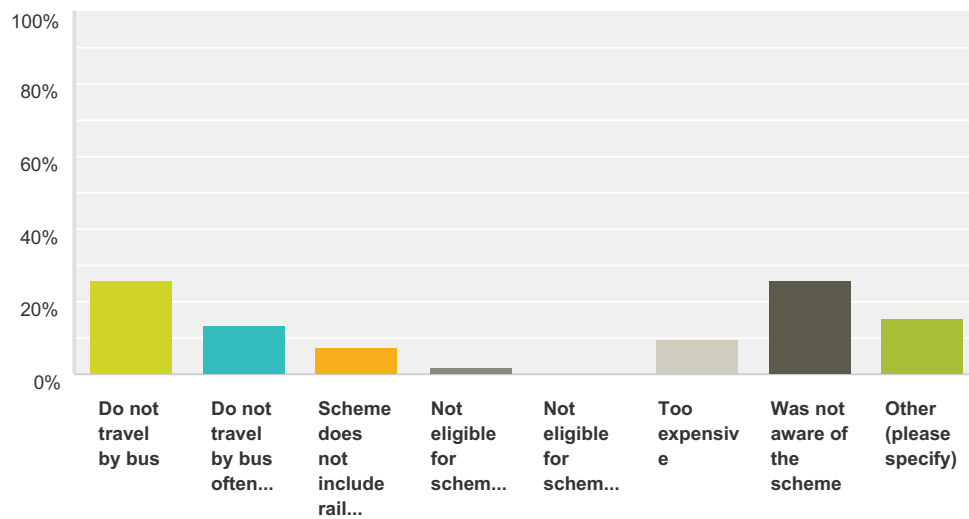

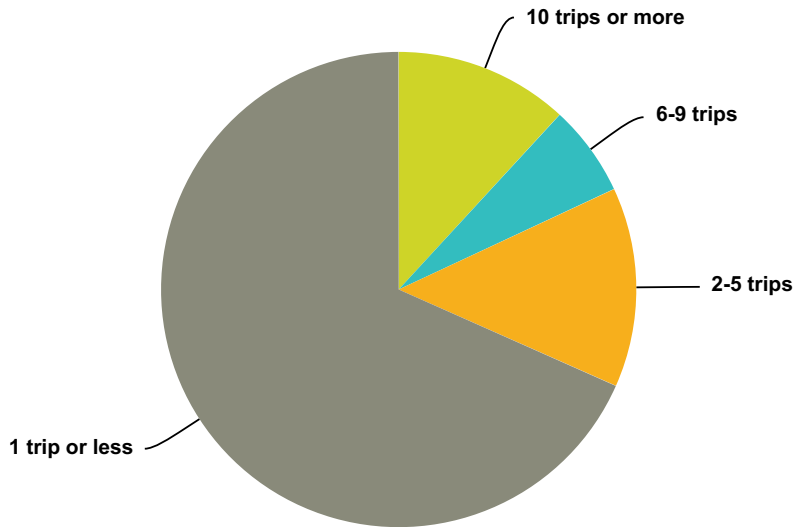

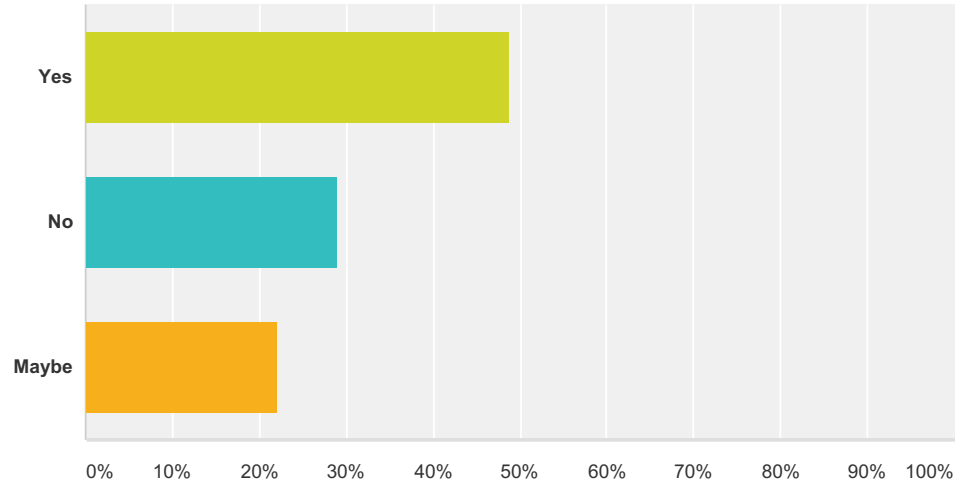

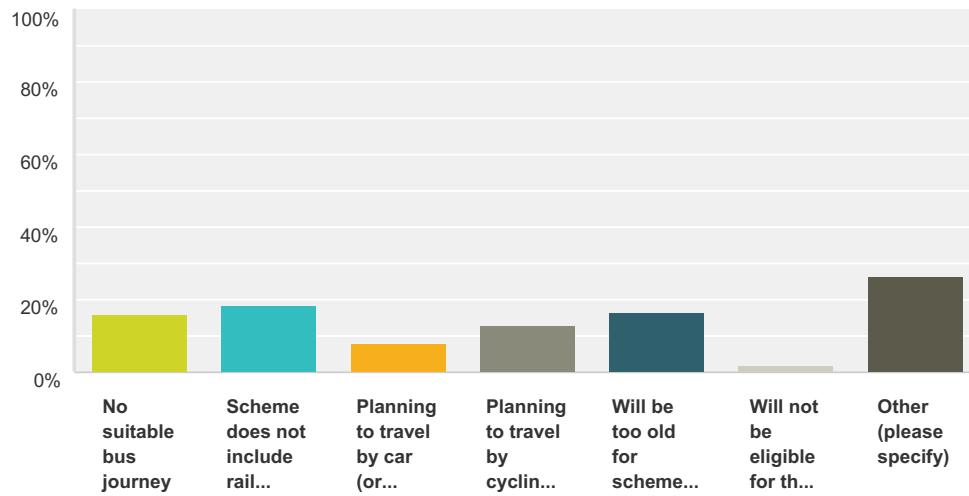

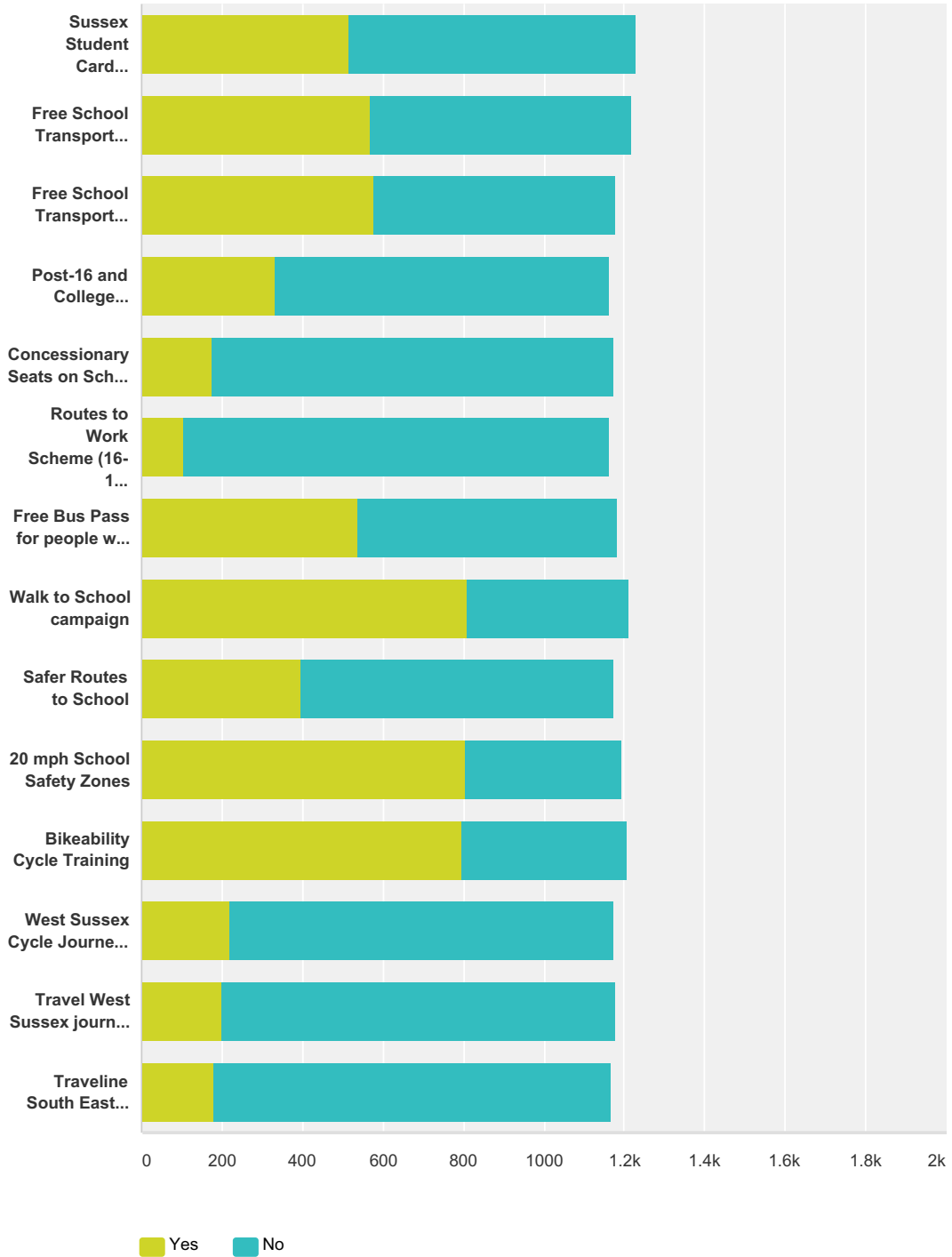

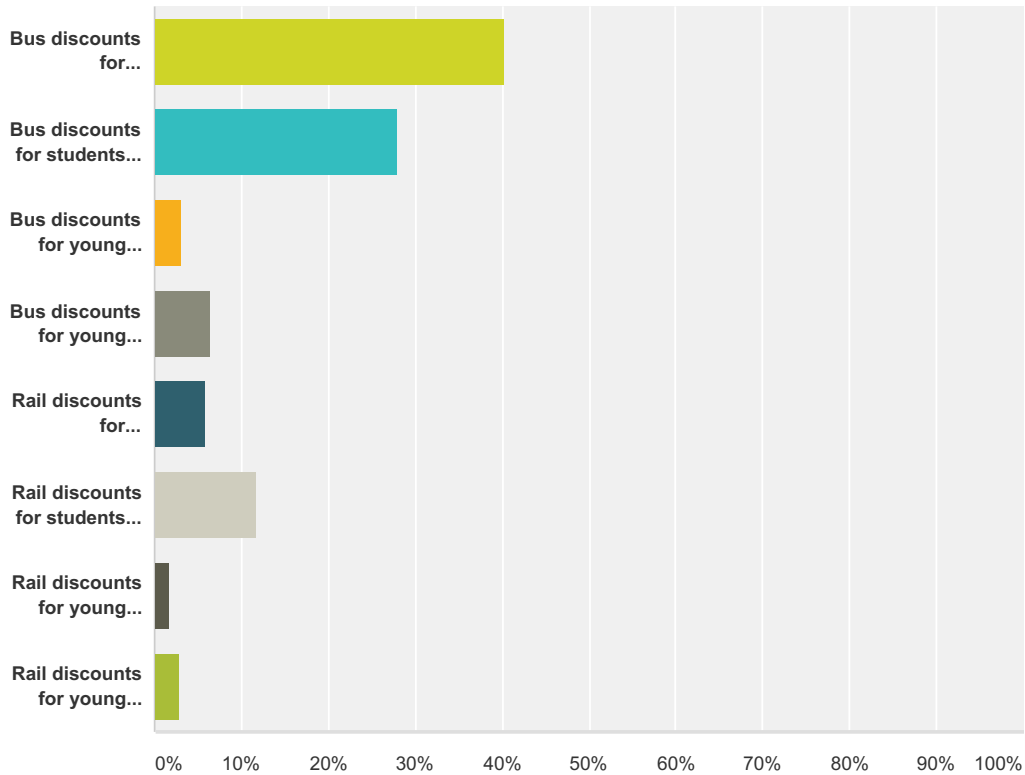

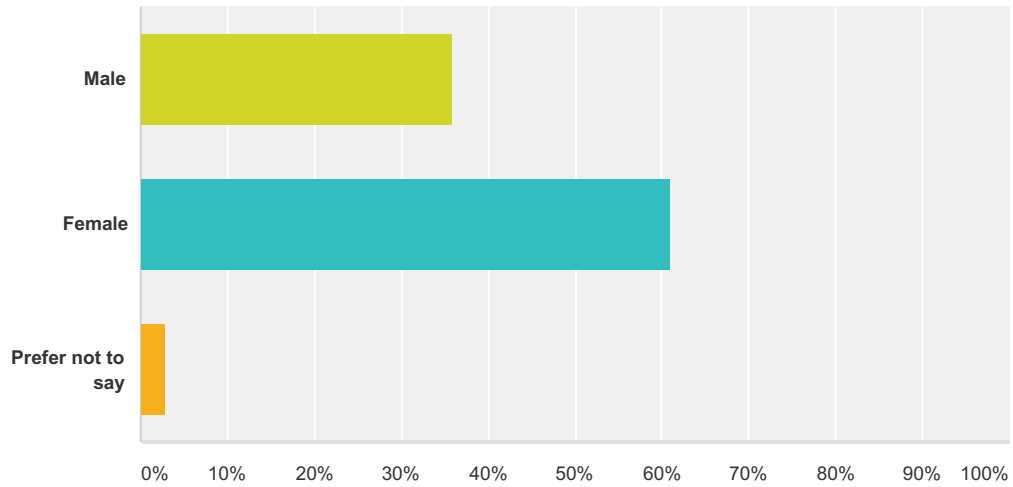

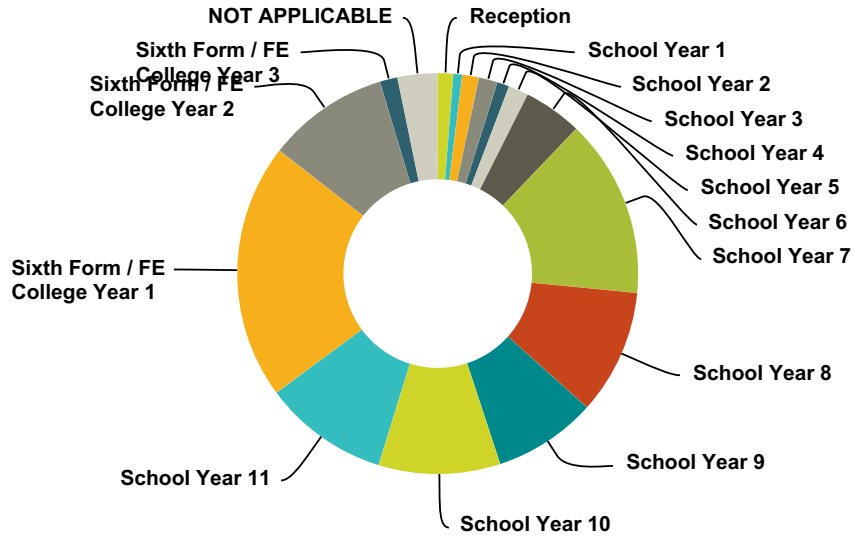

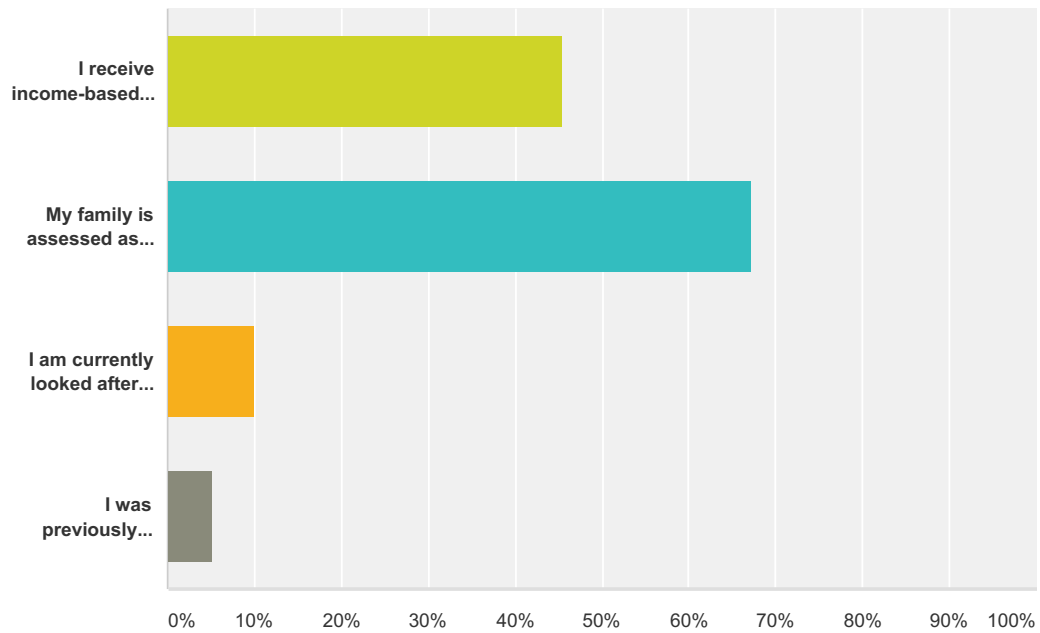

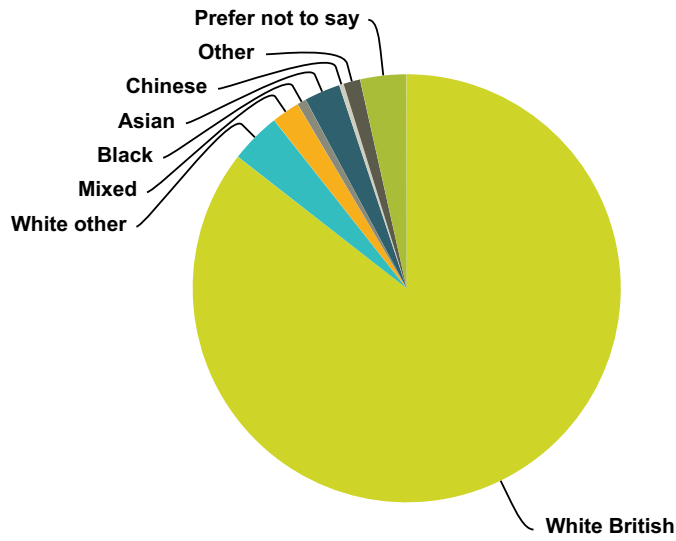

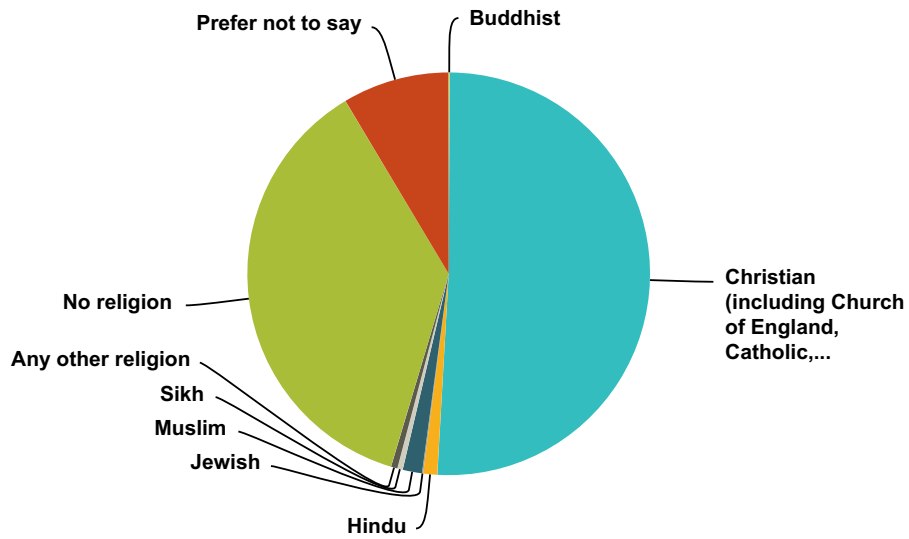

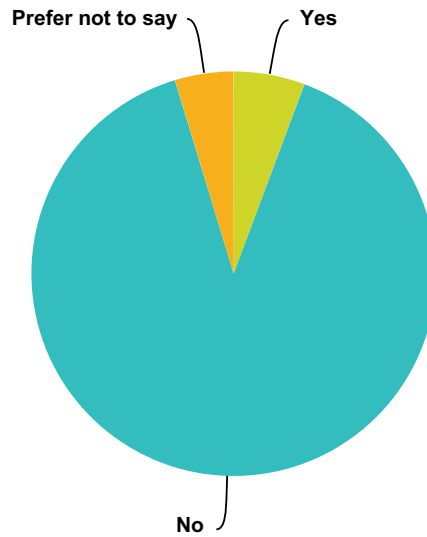

Q26 Do you consider yourself to have a disability or long-term illness?

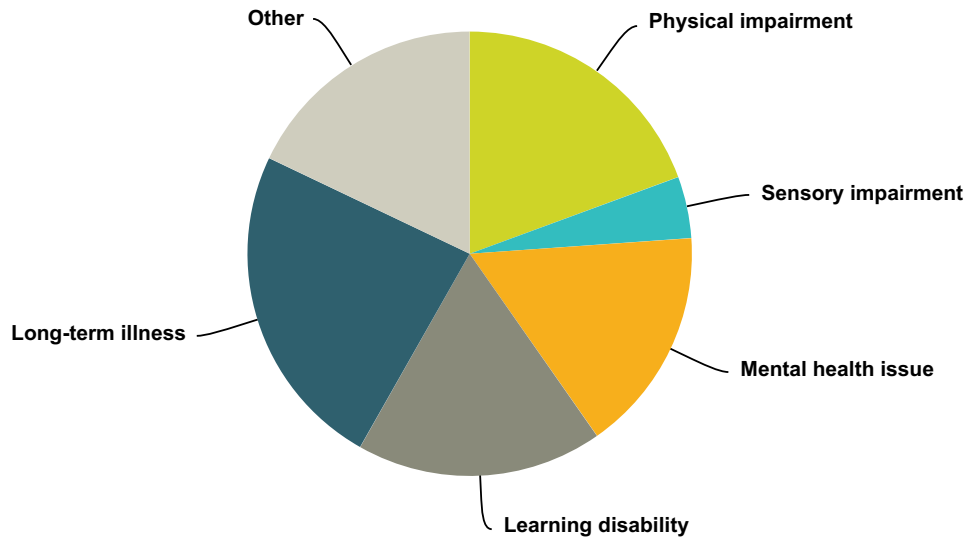
