

Confirmed changes to West Sussex supported bus services

Please see below for changes to West Sussex County Council supported bus routes to commence from the dates shown. Timetables will be added as soon as available.

From 15 April 2019

16 (Compass Bus) – Sompting and Lancing section of route reduced to run off-peak only.

19 (Compass Bus) – Peak service now reduced and using only one bus.

36A, 36C (Compass Bus) – Service withdrawn and partly replaced off-peak by diversion of route 100

62 (Compass Bus) – Timetable totally revised. Off-peak service now operates Tuesdays and Thursdays only.

64 (Compass Bus) – Service diverted via Coolham, Barns Green and Christ's Hospital.

66A, 66C (Compass Bus) – Saturday 0724 bus withdrawn. Service at 1740 withdrawn and 1635 journey put back to 1655.

69 (Compass Bus) – Service now operates 30 mins earlier (bus passes still valid). Now operates Tuesdays and Fridays only.

74, 74A, 74B (Compass Bus) – Timetable totally revised. Off-peak operates Tuesdays and Thursdays only. Saturday service withdrawn.

85, 85A (Compass Bus) – Saturday service withdrawn.

89 (Compass Bus) – Timetable totally revised. Off-peak runs Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only. Saturday service withdrawn.

93/96 (Compass Bus) – Services withdrawn.

99 – Minor timetable changes.

100 (Compass Bus) – Morning school journey timing change. Revised off-peak route and times in Burgess Hill.

150 (Compass Bus) – Service withdrawn.

From 21 April 2019

46, 47 (Stagecoach) – revised route and timetable with buses operating hourly Monday to Saturday throughout the day. All journeys to start and finish at Chichester Cathedral, no longer serving the bus station.

50 (Stagecoach) – revised route and timetable with buses operating hourly Monday to Saturday throughout the day. All journeys to start and finish at Chichester Cathedral, no longer serving the bus station. Evening journeys and a few early morning journeys

will no longer run. Through tickets are available on routes 46, 47, 50 for journeys to & from Chichester bus station.

54 (Stagecoach) – a new morning journey from Chichester to Petersfield, departing at 0600. The 1750 Chichester to South Harting will no longer run.

From 27 April 2019

65 (Metrobus) – Withdrawal of the late afternoon journeys at 1708 and 1738 from Horsham to Oakhill

84 (Metrobus) – The 1810 journey from Crawley will be withdrawn, plus minor timing changes throughout the timetable.

98 (Metrobus) – Will no longer serve Horsham Carfax on southbound journeys (towards Southwater). Horsham Bus Station and the Albion Way stop both provide a nearby alternative. Northbound journeys (towards Roffey) will continue to serve Horsham Carfax.

Times have changed throughout on each day.

The 0810 schoolday journey from Southwater is withdrawn but the 0751 journey from Cedar Drive will be operated by a double decker to provide additional capacity.

The afternoon schoolday diversion via Forest School will also serve Millais School and will be operated by a double deck vehicle.

270 (Metrobus) – The 1835 weekday journey from East Grinstead to Haywards Heath will no longer operate. A new route 291 journey from East Grinstead to Forest Row partly replaces the withdrawn 270 journey.

291 (Metrobus) – Minor timing changes to improve reliability, with an extra weekday journey from East Grinstead to Forest Row to partly replace the 1835 journey on route 270.

692 (Metrobus) – Minor changes to times of this school bus service.
