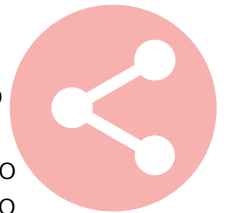
HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE FOR ME TO FILL IN?
